What does the course cover?

The qualification training runs for 10 days. It is divided into three units, each of which is assessed separately:

 - Health & Safety Management Systems 2: Organizing,
 - Health & Safety Management Systems 3: Planning
 - Health & Safety Management Systems 4: Measuring, Audit and Review
- Control of international workplace hazards (IGC2)
 - Workplace Hazards and Risk Control
 - Transport Hazards and Risk Control
 - Musculoskeletal Hazards and Risk Control
 - Work Equipment Hazards and Risk Control
 - Electrical Safety & Fire Safety
 - Chemical and Biological Health Hazards and Risk Control
 - Physical and Psychological Health Hazards and Risk Control
- International health and safety practical application (IGC3)

Materials

Each participant will receive his own NEBOSH Workbook. On successful completion of the course participant will receive NEBOSH parchments and a full certificate.
